Stamford, CT – June 18, 2009...As part of the Goldman Sachs Community TeamWorks volunteer initiative, professionals from the firm recently conducted a Day of Learning for St. Luke's LifeWorks participants. St. Luke's LifeWorks provides learning opportunities, housing and support services to people overcoming homelessness in lower Fairfield County.

Throughout the course of the GS Day of Learning, volunteers conducted three workshops. These included sessions on Resume Improvement, providing the opportunity for participants to submit their resumes in advance for review; an Interview Skills session where participants practiced their skills through video replay; and a Financial Management session to introduce important things to consider such as retirement and insurance packages once participants are working. The Day of Learning workshops tie into St. Luke's LifeWorks Life Long Learning initiative that offers participants the opportunity for career development, improved life skills, and computer training to help them become self-sufficient.

St. Luke's LifeWorks is based in Stamford and has 10 locations in Fairfield County. Programs include educational opportunities, coaching and mentoring, and housing for individuals facing homelessness, recovering from mental illness, or living with HIV/AIDS.
